The three-piece element invites children to climb, slide, hide and explore. Moveable balls in the front area show the primary colours red, green, blue and yellow. Different materials, such as the slip-resistant, soft back of the caterpillar, cool stainless steel surfaces or smooth balls help children train their tactile senses while grasping and experiencing.

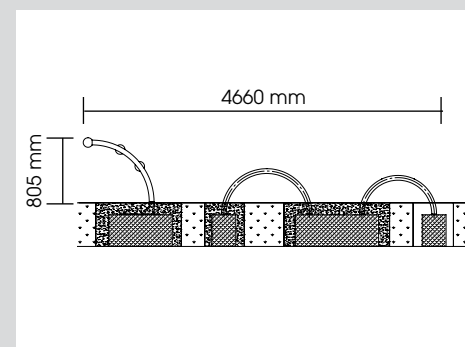
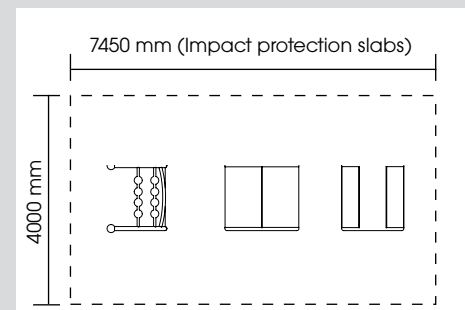
